Nov 25, 2007 "Dear children! Today, when you celebrate Christ, the King of all that is created, I desire for Him to be the King of your lives. Only through giving, little children, can you comprehend the gift of Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross for each of you. Little children, give time to God that He may transform you and fill you with His grace, so that you may be a grace for others. For you, little children, I am a gift of grace and love, which comes from God for this peaceless world. Thank you for having responded to my call."

Advent / Christmas:

/12/84 - If you follow me, this Christmas will be unforgettable for you. I tell you: turn off your television sets, your radios and follow the programme set by God of meditation, prayer and of reading the Gospel; foster the development of faith.

6/12/84 - Dear children, these days I am calling you to family prayer. In God's name many times I have been giving you messages but you did not listen. This Christmas will be unforgettable for you only if you accept the messages I am giving you.

13/12/84 - Dear children, you know that the day of joy is coming near, but without love you will attain nothing. Therefore first of all start loving your family, everyone in the parish, and then you will be able to love and accept all those who are coming here. Let this week be the week of learning to love.

20/12/84 - Today I am asking you to do something practical for Jesus Christ. On the day of joy I wish that every family of the parish brings a flower as a sign of abandonment to Jesus. I wish that every member of the family has one flower next to the crib so that Jesus can come and see your devotion to Him.

5/12/85 - Dear children, I call you to prepare yourselves for Christmas by penance, prayer, and works of charity. Do not look at things material, for then you will not be able to experience Christmas.

12/12/85 - Dear children, for Christmas I invite you to give glory to Jesus together with me. I will give Him to you in a special way on that day, and I invite you on that day to give glory and praise with me to Jesus at His birth. Dear children, pray more on that day, and think more about Jesus.

11/12/86 - Dear children, today I invite you to pray during this special season, so that you may come to experience the joy of meeting Jesus at His birth. Dear children, I wish you to live through these days in the same way as I did. It is my desire to guide you with joy and show you the joy towards which I want to lead each of you. For that reason, dear children, pray and surrender yourselves completely to me.

25/12/87 - Dear children, rejoice with me. My heart rejoices because of Jesus and today I wish to give Him to you. I want each one of you, dear children, to open your hearts to Jesus. I will give Him to you lovingly. It is my wish that He will change you, teach you, protect you. Today, I am praying in a special way for each of you and presenting you to God. Thus He will reveal Himself to you. I am calling you to sincere prayer of the heart so that your every prayer may be a meeting point with God. Every single day let Him take first place in your work and in your life.

Nov 25, 2002 "Dear children! I call you also today to conversion. Open your heart to God, little children, through Holy Confession and prepare your soul so that little Jesus can be born anew in your heart. Permit Him to transform you and lead you on the way of peace and joy. Little children, decide for prayer. Especially now, in this time of grace, may your heart yearn for prayer.
